A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA REPUBLICAN PARTY STATE CONVENTION CALLING FOR U.S. SENATE APPROVAL OF ANY TREATY WITH IRAN

Passed by the Orangeburg County Republican Party Convention – April 18, 2015

WHEREAS, the Obama administration has attempted to negotiate a deal preventing the proliferation of nuclear weapons to the Islamic State of Iran; and

WHEREAS, the details of this negotiation have not been shared with members of the Legislative branch of government as required by the treaty-making provisions of the United States Constitution; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the South Carolina Republican Party State Convention calls upon our Congressional delegation do all in its power to see that any treaty negotiated by the Executive Branch with Iran must be submitted to the United States Senate for its approval before taking effect, as required by the United States Constitution.
