A RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT DIVERSITY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION (DEI) PRACTICES IN THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, the principles of equality and merit-based employment are fundamental to the fair and just operation of state government; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) programs in state employment has been criticized for potentially promoting division, encouraging reverse discrimination, and diverting public funds from core governmental services; and

WHEREAS, several states have already moved to restrict or eliminate such programs, recognizing the need for a focus on merit, individual capability, and equal opportunity rather than quotas or identity-based considerations; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative to ensure that state employment practices are free from any form of discrimination or preferential treatment based on race, gender, sexual orientation, or other non-merit factors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE SOUTH CAROLINA REPUBLICAN PARTY COMMENDS THE SC HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND FULLY SUPPORTS H 3927 THAT Essentially:

- Prohibits DEI Programs
- Bans DEI Statements
- Reallocates Existing DEI Resources
