

**RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA REPUBLICAN PARTY IN SUPPORT  
FOR PARTISAN SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, South Carolina Republican Primary voters overwhelmingly voted in favor of making school board elections partisan in 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, South Carolina voters deserve to understand the political leanings of elected officials; and

**WHEREAS**, school board policies may be at odds with the Republican Party Platform;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, therefore let it be it RESOLVED, that the South Carolina Republican Party supports partisan elections for school board; and

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the South Carolina Republican Party calls on the South Carolina legislature to pass H 4952, making South Carolina School Board elections partisan; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that upon passage of this resolution, that it be delivered electronically and via postal service to members of the State House and State Senate, the Governor of South Carolina, the Speaker of the South Carolina House, the State House Majority Leader, the President of the State Senate and the State Senate Majority Leader.
